# Enrollment Data

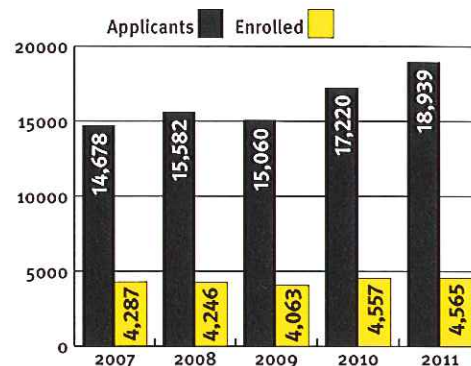
When we reached our five-year enrollment goal last fall, we decided to maintain that level in 2011 if at all possible. Yet, the fall 2011 enrollment exceeded the record set in 2010 in several important ways.

The total first-year enrollment is 4,565, eight students more than in 2010. One of the hallmarks of the Class of 2015 is its diversity: 45 percent are from Iowa, 44 percent are from other states and 11 percent are international. Minority students from the U.S. make up a record 14 percent of the class. The academic credentials of our student body continue to increase, which also is reflected in our 86 percent first- to second-year retention rate for students who entered last fall.

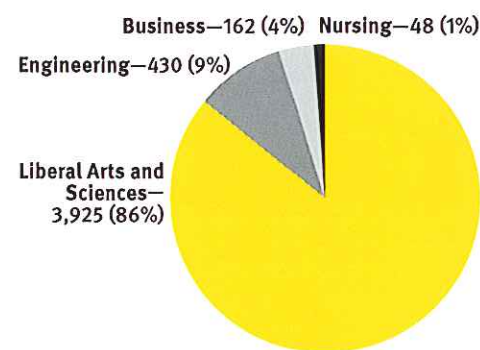

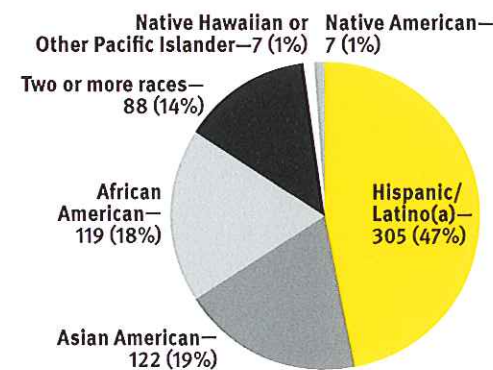

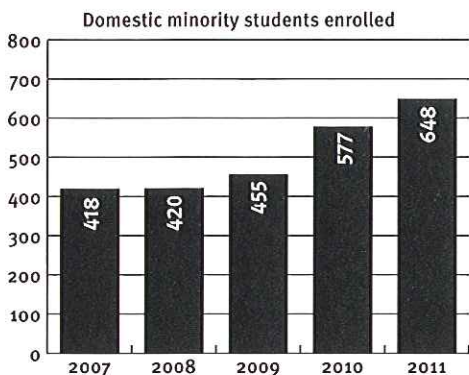

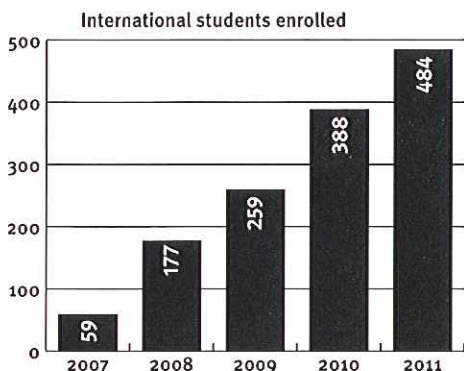




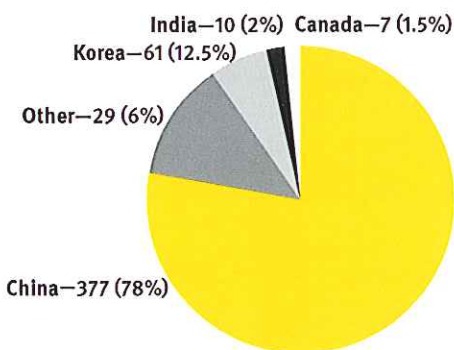

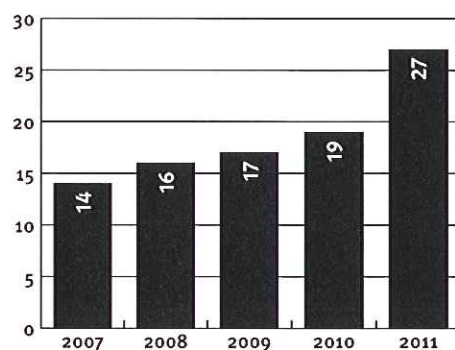

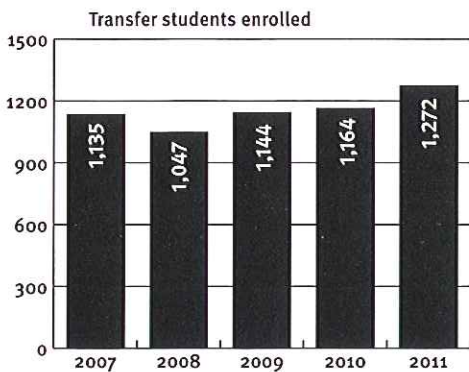

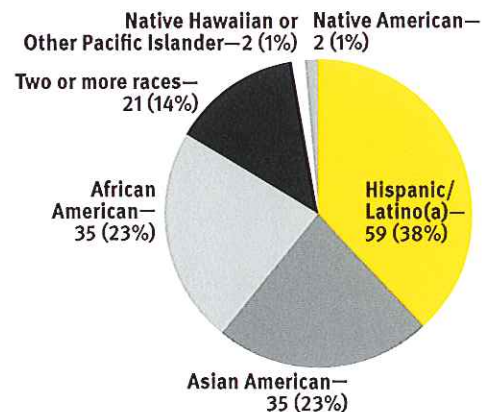
